## WHAT KIND OF ANIMAL WOULD YOU BE?

If you could be any animal, which one would you be? Most people say a bird. Others would want to be a lion or cheetah or tiger – strong, top-of-the-food chain survivors. But I wonder how many people would want to be a vulture, cowbird, or sloth. I doubt very many. But a lot of people live their lives like those animals.

(1). *Vulture*. Vultures love death. They love when other animals kill each other. They'll fly over fresh food to get to a rotting carcass. Are you that way? Do you prefer disasters? Do you like it when others fail so you can swoop in and exploit the situation for your benefit?

(2). *Cowbirds*. Cowbirds belong to a group of birds called "brood parasites." The cowbird lays her eggs in other birds' nests. If the host bird removes the cowbird egg, the female cowbird will kill the host bird. You're a cowbird kind of person if you rely on others' resources to advance yourself. You let other people build the nest, then you take advantage of them.

(3). *Sloth*. Sloths aren't always just lying around getting moldy. Sloths can actually run pretty fast when chased by a predator. Otherwise, they don't move. They are so slow that moths, beetles, cockroaches, fungi, and algae can easily grow in their hair. Are you a sloth? Do you only "move" when you have to, when there is an emergency? Or do you get involved in whatever good work that needs to be done?

Of all God's creatures to compare yourself to, you might want to consider the ant. The common American field ant can withstand pressures of about 5,000 times its body weight. Scientists say the ant neck joint has a particular construction, which keeps the ant from being crushed by leaves and grass. With God's help, we can often find strength we never thought we had.
